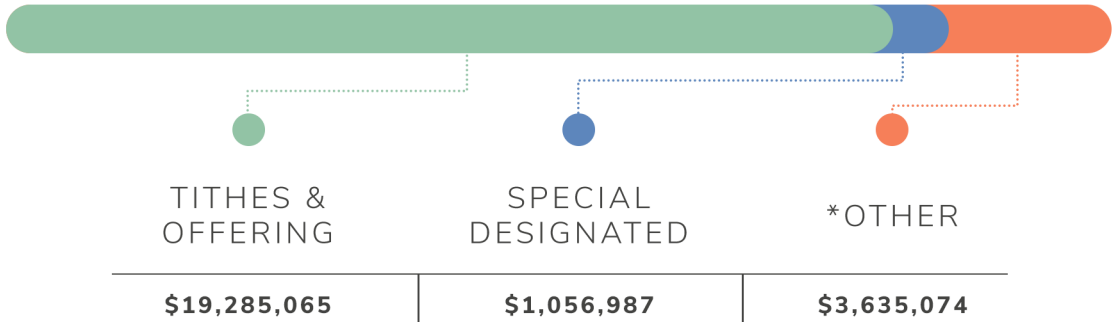

TOTAL \$23,977,126

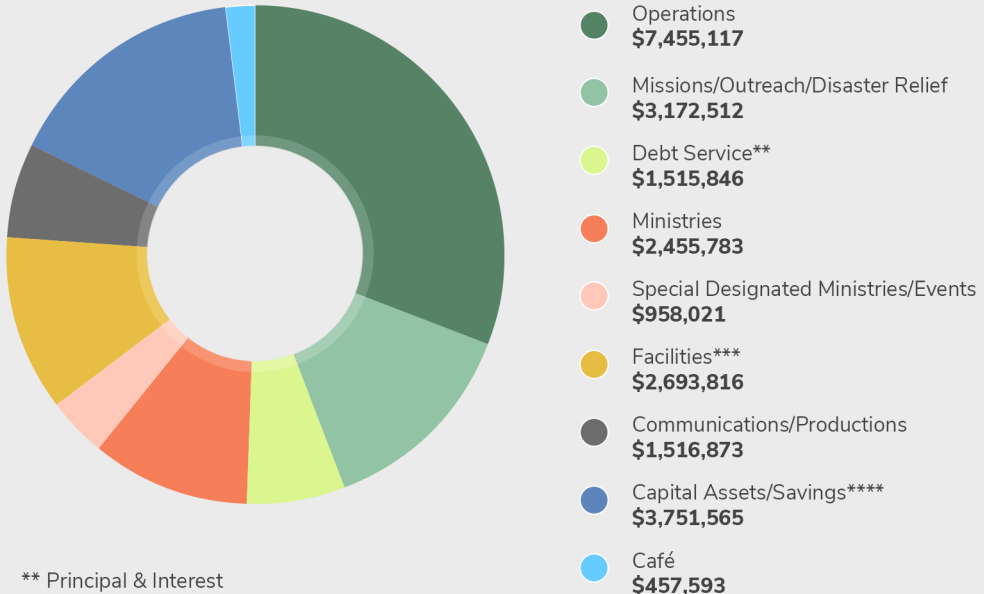
