- Silence in Heaven for 30 min, fire mingled with prayers of the saints hurled to Earth

7 _____ (Revelation 8-9, 11:15-19)

- Hail + fire + blood rain down, 1/3 plants are destroyed
- Burning mountain thrown into ocean, 1/3 sea turns to blood, 1/3 fish die, 1/3 ships destroyed

- Burning star falls on fresh water, 1/3 becomes poisoned (bitter)
- Sun, moon, and stars have 1/3 reduced brightness
- Plague of demonic locusts
- Plague of demonic horsemen, 1/3 of humanity wiped out
- Temple in Heaven opened, lightning, thunder, earthquake, hailstorm

7 _____ (Revelation 15-16)

- Boils on everyone who took the mark of the beast
- Sea turns to blood
- Rivers and lakes turn to blood
- Sun scorches people
- Darkness
- River Euphrates dries up
- Huge earthquake, most cities destroyed, 100 lbs. hailstones
